Bay Harbor Golf Club is beautifully poised upon the stately bluffs overlooking Lake Michigan and Little Traverse Bay, within the heart of one of the most picturesque locations in the Midwest. A view of Lake Michigan and the eighteenth green of the Bay Harbor Golf Course is framed like a living portrait by birch trees through large windows of the dining room and bar.

The first nine holes, The Links, is reminiscent of the Great Irish Seaside courses, The Links has miles of Lake Michigan shoreline forming a backdrop for this incomparable beauty. Accented with towering bluffs and dunes this course is a stunning achievement in the sport of golf.

The second nine, the Quarry Course features a forty-foot gorge with shale cliffs, ponds and waterfall make this natural course a truly unique experience with the final three holes along Lake Michigan. "GOLF WEEK" selected the Links/Quarry 43rd among "America's 100 Best Modern Courses" for 1997, 61st for 1998 and 33rd for 1999. "GOLF Magazine" chose the same combination 8th in the 1998 category of "Top 100 Courses You Can Play in the U.S."
