Where else can you experience playing the combined history of 14 U.S. Opens, 11 PGA Championships, 8 U.S. Amateurs, and 3 Ryder Cup. The Donald Ross Memorial is a composite of classic golf holes designed by Donald Ross in the early part of the century and re-created at in northern Michigan from some of the architect's most renowned courses including Oakland Hills, Seminole Golf Club, Pinehurst #2, Inverness, and Oak Hill. With tight tree lined fairways and strategically placed bunkers, this course is beautiful and will provide an ample challenge for any skilled golfer.
